## “Vollendet ist das große Werk”

Franz Joseph Haydn (1732-1809) composed *The Creation* late in his career (between 1796-1798). In this masterpiece, Haydn combined the traditions of Handel’s oratorio and the Viennese mass with his own symphonic style to depict and celebrate the creation of the world using large musical forces: a classical orchestra, five soloists, and chorus. “Vollendet ist das große Werk” is a chorus arranged for treble voices from *The Creation*.

## “Cum Sancto Spiritu”

“Cum Sancto Spiritu” is the third movement from Hyo-won Woo’s *Gloria* which combines both western musical concepts and the traditional Korean musical scale, along with rhythmic patterns called Jangdan (meaning long-short).
